11. He found out that I was Italienne and he **no longer wanted** (*=ne [vouloir] plus*) *mon numéro de téléphone!*
12. I was going to go out, but (*=mais*) it was raining.
13. She was going to study, but she wanted to watch TV!
14. They were reading **while** I was listening to music.
15. I was sleeping **while** she was finishing *son devoir*.
16. I studied **until** 11:00.
