

Practicing **-er** verbs and conjugation

Remember—these are the **SUBJECT PRONOUNS**:

je = *I*

nous = *we*

tu = *you* (familiar)

vous = *you all* OR *you* (formal)

il = *he*

ils = *they* (all guys or mixed group)

elle = *she*

elles = *they* (all girls)

For these, also use "il" verb form "ending"

Bob = (use anyone's name)

Qui? = *who*

tout le monde = *everyone, everybody*

Assignment for each of the **-er verbs** on the list:

verbs

You will write the verb **1 time** as the *infinitif* and then write it CONJUGATED **two** times. EACH TIME, you must conjugate it for a different set of 2 of the subject pronouns (see above). You may choose which pronouns to use, but vary them from verb to verb. **Then**, finish it off IN ENGLISH, with something to show the context of the verb. THEN **translate the French part**. Here is an example:

EXAMPLE for ONE verb:

parler : = to speak

nous **parlons** French in Mme Chabot's class = **we speak**

ils **parlent** at the movies, and I hate it! = **they talk**

(So, for the next verb, you might use *elle*, and *vous*... and for the next verb, you might use *je*, and *tout le monde*, etc.)

- Please number your sets, and **start with the infinitive**
- Please underline or **highlight** the subject and verb **and** the infinitive
- For **téléphoner** (à) be sure to put a person's name or a noun for a person, in French... like, *je téléphone à ma copine* OR *il téléphone à Marie*.
