

FRANÇAIS I

DEVOIR:

- Using the new *-ir* verbs, write **30** Franais sentences like this: Put the subject and verb in French (conjugate the verb! Vary your subjects and verbs!). Then, finish off the sentence with, "*parce que...*" and give the reason the action is happening, in English. **TRANSLATE the French** in parentheses at the end.

EX: 1. **Elle rougit** , *parce que...* her boyfriend said she was pretty. (*She is blushing*)

REMEMBER:

- Don't put anything BETWEEN the **subject** and **verb** (between **elle** and **rougit**, for example).... So no "will" "wants to" "likes to" "hates to" "would" "can" "can't", etc.
- **PRESENT TENSE!** Make sure you are translating as present tense, not talking about the past.

EX:

PRESENT (Yes!): I choose OR I am choosing ; I finish OR I am finishing

PAST (No ☹): I chose ; I finished

- You can add a word or two after the verb (even in English) to make your sentence make sense, before you get to the **parce que**:

Ex: **Il choisit** *chocolate ice cream* **parce que** he doesn't like other flavors. (= *he chooses*)

- Be sure to **underline** or **highlight** the French words for me
