- Be sure you can give the GENDER of each item (you will actually see the French word) EX: $\qquad$ croissant ( --> un croissant)
- Be sure you know what the English word is, and/or a description of the item
EX: $\qquad$ croque monsieur ( --> un croque monsieur = a grilled ham and cheese sandwich)


## Hunger and Thirst

- Be sure you know how to say, "I am hungry" and "I am thirsty" , and
"Are you hungry?" and "Are you thirsty?" to your friends or family


## Talking about Food / Drinks with Friends and Waiters

- Be sure you know the "familiar" and "formal" phrases for "thank you"
- Be sure you know the "familiar" and "formal" phrases for saying,
"Give me...." and "I want.." or "I would like..."
- Be sure you know the "familiar" question, "What do you want?"
- Be sure you know the "formal" questions, "May I help you?" and "And, with that?"
- Be sure you know how to ask the waiter how much a SPECIFIC item costs, and how much to TOTAL BILL comes to
- Be sure you know the "familiar" phrase for asking a friend, "Loan me..."
